Fr. Míchael wrítes:



'Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near. 'These are the words of the Entrance Antiphon of today's Mass written by St Paul in his Letter to the Phillipians (4:4-5). They are also the words which give this 'Gaudete Sunday' its name, from the old Latin of the liturgy before 1970, when the Entrance Antiphon was 'Gaudete in Domino semper; iterum dico, Gaudete. Dominus enim prope est.' We don't in the parish have the habit of reading the Entrance Antiphon at the beginning of Sunday Mass, which in any case is replaced often by an opening hymn, but if we were in a monastery or in Westminster Cathedral, the Antiphon would be chanted as the monks, nuns or priests processed to the altar. But what is St Paul urging us all to rejoice about? The nearness of the Lord. He, in fact, is talking about rejoicing in the nearness of Christ's Second Coming - rejoicing in the prospect of the Risen and Ascended Lord coming in glory on the clouds of heaven for Judgement Day! We, on the other hand, are more rejoicing in the nearness of Christ at Christmas, which is also the Church's invitation to us in this second phase of Advent without neglecting our looking forward to the Lord's return in glory at the end of time. For whether we are rejoicing in the nearness of the Lord at Christmas or His Second Coming, the witness of our joy is to be the same. The joke runs, 'Jesus is coming – so look busy!' but being busy won't be enough. The true witness of our joy at the nearness of the Lord must be our love. 'In the evening of life we will be judged by our love,' says St John of the Cross whose feast day is on Wednesday. If we have confidence in the love we have lived in our lives then we can rejoice in the nearness of Judgement Day. In the mean time, the joy we have at Christmas is the more authentic Christian rejoicing the more we give witness to it by our love, in all the manifold ways in which love is lived. Then we will be ready to go out an dmeet Him both at Christmas and at the end of time.
