Tomas wrítes:-

The first two readings for this Sunday are related to Wisdom which is, above all, the understanding of the plan of God to reveal His merciful love through the death of Our Lord. But how then do we become wise? Wisdom is - above all - a gift. The Holy Spirit gives us a share in the resurrected life of Our Lord, and the same Spirit will continue to develop that life in us, transforming our broken natures so that we become images and likenesses of God. Our spiritual maturity is thus closely connected to our growth in Wisdom. This Wisdom is one of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, together with Counsel, Understanding, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of God. The gift of Knowledge helps us to judge rightly the truths of Christian faith, the gift of Understanding gives us a deeper insight into those divine truths. And the gift of Wisdom empowers us to judge and order all things in accordance with our Christian belief, relying on these revealed truths. While Knowledge and Understanding enable us to understand the divine truths, it is the gift of Wisdom that helps us to perceive our entire lives through our faith. By viewing our lives from the perspective of the truths in which we believe, we grow in union with God. Where Understanding is more a matter of mind, an intellectual achievement, Wisdom in an experience of the heart. When our genuine love for Christ penetrates our heart, it reaches great depths which intellect is unable to speculate about. This was the case of many saints whose wisdom often surpassed knowledge, for it was wisdom resulting from acts of deep prayer and – above all – *charity*. As the Holy Spirit transforms us according to the love found in Christ, we begin to comprehend the charity that God has revealed through his Cross. And as we grow in charity and charity continues to grow within us, we become more Christ-like, and love reaches the deepest corners of our souls. Through the love of Christ and in the Holy Spirit we arise above the mere "wisdom" of the world, embracing the gift of Wisdom, immersed in the irresistible love of God. Only through this transformation of our hearts by the love of Jesus poured into them by the Holy Spirit can we begin to comprehend its unsearchable riches. The gift of Wisdom is thus born when we contemplate the divine, but it brings practical fruits every day when we order our lives according to it, evaluating everything from the point of view of our faith, and avoiding worldly trappings. Come, Holy Spirit, and give us a share in your Wisdom which our world needs so much.
