Fr Michael writes:

As May in the Church is the month of Mary, so June is the month of the Sacred Heart. The Feast itself this year, or rather, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, is not until Friday 24th June, but we are invited well before then to contemplate afresh the attractiveness and accessibility of this devotion: Our Lord's open arms, His Sacred Heart aflame with love for us, and for the whole world, and the warmth of His gaze. These all remind us of His wanting firstly to be with us and then to do whatever is necessary, whether to console us, encourage us, but somehow to shepherd and lead us home, day by day, to the very heart of God which we celebrate this Sunday in the Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and which He Himself manifests in His Sacred Heart.

"...the community devastated"

We pray very much this weekend for the devastated Catholic parish community of St Francis Xavier, Ondo State, southwest Nigeria. Celebrating the joy of Pentecost Mass last Sunday two men of unknown origin, wielding guns, fired indiscriminately into the congregation killing over 50, including children, before fleeing, and are as yet unapprehended. The bishop has appealed "that we remain calm, law abiding and pray for peace to return to our community, state and country", the parish spokesperson said. So much suffering has been asked of them to witness to a love that seeks to transform the world and all hearts within it; to free us and heal us from the grotesque disfigurements of the heart that sin can bring about. For the onward mission of the Church

The month of the Sacred Heart is also the month of the diocesan ordinations to the Priesthood, this year on the Feast most closely associated with the Sacred Heart, namely, the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Saturday 25th June. These ordinations enable many other moves. One such move is of most significance to Chiswick as it concerns Fr Daniel. Impelled as he is by a strong sense of mission (cf 2Cor 5:14) – which brought him to our diocese and parishes – he offered himself to the Cardinal for 'Missio ad gentes' to be sent further afield for the mission and has learned that he is to go to the Diocese of Plymouth for some years. The move is scheduled for September so we'll have time for a Farewell Mass before departure. In the mean time, his successor has been announced also, the yet-to-be-priestly-ordained Deacon Dan Daley. Deacon Dan will be ordained priest on 25th June and come to us as Fr Dan I hope in early September. Bishop John Mbinda's Holy Ghost Father replacement has also been announced by the Spiritans and the Diocese. We will look forward to welcoming Fr Erasmus Onyema Egenonu CSSp also in September.

In these very difficult days with the spiralling cost of living, parishioners have been consistently generous to the Lent Project begun on Ash Wednesday and which closed last Pentecost Sunday

The CARDINAL'S APPEAL, our domestic charity supporting social outreach projects across the diocese has received £5,180.01 COMBONI-150, our overseas project both celebrating the Comboni Missionary Sisters 150th anniversary of foundation as well as supporting one of their life and environment changing projects is to receive £5,377.66. Sr Rosemary Herrera, the Comboni Sister co-ordinating the project in Arequipa, Peru, was hoping the parish might raise £4,855 in her costed submission asking for help to create two bio-gardens providing sustainable development for a village of subsistence income, together with interim food parcels.

These figures are inclusive of reclaimed Gift Aid on those donations which were eligible for Gift Aid.
