Fr Michael writes:

I'm delighted to introduce the presence in the parish this weekend of the Catholic Union, the country's pre-eminent organisation of Catholic laity, inviting interest in their great work and service to the Church and the common good.

The Catholic Union writes:

We are delighted to have the opportunity to tell the parishioners of Chiswick about the work of the Catholic Union of Great Britain. We are an organisation of lay Catholics whose mission is to educate and inform the Government, Parliament and the wider public about the Catholic viewpoint on the issues of the day, and to urge that Catholic interests are taken fully into account. **In short, we want the Catholic voice to be clearly and thoughtfully articulated, understood and respected in the public life of our country.**

Founded in 1870, we are non-party political and have support from all parties. Our current President is Conservative backbencher Sir Edward Leigh MP and his predecessor was Labour peer Lord Brennan. We work closely with Catholic and other Christian parliamentarians, with the Catholic Bishops' Conferences and Catholic organisations to make submissions on draft legislation or proposed Government policy. For instance, we argued successfully for the early reopening of churches during the pandemic and for new police guidance on the Last Rites following the death of Sir David Amess.

We have commented recently on proposals to amend the Human Rights Act and to enact a ban on "conversion therapy". We also made submissions to the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Human Rights about freedom of expression, the human rights implications of Covid regulations, and abortion law in Northern Ireland. We have written to the Chancellor urging a fairer tax system for families and to the Foreign Office urging support for persecuted Christians and others in the run-up to the international conference on freedom of religion or belief to be held in London in July.

You can read about these and other actions in a Summary which we have prepared for this membership appeal and will be distributing at all Masses along with our membership application form. Of course, like other organisations we need your moral and financial support! All lay Catholics in Great Britain are invited to join us and support our efforts. Members receive a Weekly Briefing email with a succinct and highly readable summary of the week's news and we also organise lectures, webinars and social events, many of which take place in London. We also hold an annual Summer Gathering which this year takes place at Oscott Seminary near Birmingham on 23 July. There are opportunities to get involved as a volunteer and to contribute your expertise and opinions. Please join us!

LENT PROJECT 2022:

As pre-pandemic, we'll have a dual Lent Project, one *domestic* and one *overseas*. **£9718 has been donated to date. Thank you.**

The CARDINAL'S APPEAL is our domestic project and this year the appeal will fund parish social outreach projects and Caritas Westminster (celebrating this year its 10th year of foundation) social outreach projects. For what it does and which projects are supported see: <https://www.caritaswestminster.org.uk/> There are specific Cardinal's Appeal envelopes at the exits of the church.

COMBONI-150 is our overseas project, celebrating also the 150th anniversary of foundation of the Comboni Missionaries. All funds given through the parish will assist Comboni Sr Rosemary Herrera in Arequipa, Peru, hoping for a total of £4855. **The project aims to provide two bio-gardens as 'sow a seed and you feed a village' but also, in the interim, some food parcels and meals to those developing these gardens which will belong to the villagers.**

CASH placed in the Lent Project money box at the main doors of the church will be divided 65% for Comboni-150 and 35% Cardinal's Appeal. Cash placed in envelopes made for either charity and handed into the collection or the presbytery will go 100% to the named charity. Cheques should be payable to 'Our Lady of Grace and St Edward's Church' and come in an envelope marked with the designated charity.
