## Fr Míchael wrítes:

CHRISTMAS mince pies, iced cakes and chocolate selections are *already* in the supermarkets I was amazed to find last week. Christmas trees are in shops for sale and, more surprisingly, a few homes appear to have them, unless they've been up since last year. Is this earlier than ever, I wonder? There are thirtysix shopping days to go before the First Sunday of Advent, let alone the festive season itself, another twenty four shopping days beyond that. On the other hand, one fruit of being reminded this early of Christmas is that our familiarity with the joy of that season can inspire us also to celebrate with joy World Mission Sunday next week. It was an angel on Christmas Night after all who told shepherds - momentarily not watching their flocks because terrified by the angels – "I bring you news of great joy, a joy to be shared to all people? (Lk2:10). Next Sunday the Church across the world will be unified in prayer and support for *mission*, which is to say, sharing the joy of the Incarnation, of God being with us, indeed, as us. The theme the Holy Father has chosen this year is: 'You shall be my witnesses (Acts 1:8). In his message for World Mission Sunday, he says: 'The same Spirit which guides the universal Church also inspires ordinary men and women to undertake extraordinary missions. And so it was that two hundred years ago, a young French woman – Blessed Pauline Jaricot – founded the Association for the Propagation of the Faith. She established a network of prayer and fundraising for missionaries, so that the faithful could actively participate in God's mission "to the ends of the earth". It's well worth noting that Blessed Pauline's 'undertaking an extraordinary mission' didn't mean she left her country, vital as that is for others on their respective extraordinary missions. Being witnesses of the Gospel is not an optional extra for a Christian: the option is where we witness not that we witness.

This is a helpful reflection as we contemplate our numbers and our mission here in Chiswick, Gunnersbury and Grove Park after the official count of the congregations over the last four weeks. For once we have a round-ish number, 950 attending Mass each weekend. It is encouraging, thanks be to God, with more parishioners returning to practice and new parishioners arriving in since the pandemic. The same statistic in 2021 was 818. In 2020, still within the pandemic and with limited opening and social distancing in church, the number was 494. In 2019, before the pandemic, we were 1534. Thus we may happily respond to the Lord's pointed question concluding today's Gospel - "When the Son of Man comes, will he find any faith on earth? "(Lk 18:8) – with a collective ves in His parishes here while we are still here. But let us also discern both for here and for the wider world, how we might, with the grace of God, better be His witnesses.

SCHOOL APPLICATIONS, SECONDARY AND PRIMARY, 2022. To obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP), if your Catholic practice allows for it, you should firstly contact the Parish Office to request an appointment and collect a self-assessment form (which can also be sent electronically). You should secondly complete the self-assessment form and bring it to your appointment with Fr Michael. You should not bring blank CCPs from schools. If you are a Catholic but not a practising Catholic, it will be impossible to issue a CCP as it is certifying actual Catholic practice of habitually attending weekly Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation over several years. The period of churches being closed is irrelevant because Catholic practice is to be evidenced over several years. It is also *perfectly feasible* to submit an application to a Catholic school without a CCP. The application would be categorised according to the admission criteria published by the school. Phone or email the office for a 10-minute slot this week within: Tuesday 18th Oct 3.30-6.30pm; or Friday 21st Oct 3.30-5.30pm.
