## Fr Michael writes:

King Charles III has learned from Cardinal Vincent of the heartfelt prayers of the Catholic community for his late mother Queen Elizabeth. His Majesty responded by asking the Cardinal to ensure that the Catholics of our diocese know of his thanks and gratitude for these prayers. We will rightly include ourselves in the King's sentiments given that we celebrated our parish's Requiem Mass for Her late Majesty last Sunday. May she rest in peace. The meeting of King and Cardinal took place on Friday when His Majesty invited senior faith leaders to Buckingham Palace to address them. "I have always thought of Britain as a 'community of communities'," he said, with the Sovereign having a duty "to protect the diversity of our country, including by protecting the space for Faith itself and its practice through the religions, cultures, traditions and beliefs to which our hearts and minds direct us as individuals... As a member of the Church of England, my Christian beliefs have love at their very heart... The beliefs that flourish in, and contribute to, our richly diverse society differ. They, and our society, can only thrive through a clear collective commitment to those vital principles of freedom of conscience, generosity of spirit and care for others which are, to me, the essence of our nationhood. I am determined, as King, to preserve and promote those principles across all communities, and for all beliefs, with all my heart."

May God bless and save our King.

ALTAR SERVING RECRUITMENT - At 4.00pm Sunday 2nd Oct in church our parish Master of Ceremonies, Jim Cullen, is offering altar serving triaining for new servers. All parish children who have made their First Holy Communion are welcome to attend the session which will last for one hour. At least one parent must attend the session also. New servers, supported by their parents, will need to be ready to attend the 11.00am Sunday Mass for some time before they can return to serve at a different weekend Mass.

DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM is on Saturday 24th Sept but a coach has not been arranged by our parish nor by our deanery. Although technically pilgrims are to go on parishsponsored coaches it might be feasible to join the day there by private car. The Mass, celebrated by the Cardinal, is at 12.00 noon with the walk along the Holy Mile at 2.15pm. SCHOOL APPLICATIONS, SECONDARY AND PRIMARY, 2022. To obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP), if your Catholic practice allows for it, you should firstly contact the Parish Office to request an appointment and collect a self-assessment form (which can also be sent electronically). You should **secondly** complete the self-assessment form and bring it to your appointment with Fr Michael. You should not bring blank CCPs from schools. If you are a Catholic but not a practising Catholic, it will be impossible to issue a CCP as it is certifying actual Catholic practice of habitually attending weekly Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation over several years. The period of churches being closed is irrelevant because Catholic practice is to be evidenced over several years. It is also perfectly feasible to submit an application to a Catholic school without a CCP. The application would be categorised according to the admission criteria published by the school. Phone or email the office for a 10-minute slot this week within: Weds 21st 3.00-5.50pm; Thurs 22<sup>nd</sup> 3.00-4.00pm; Fri 23<sup>rd</sup> 3.30pm-5.30pm.

BAPTISM - Apply for infant baptism currently either with the wallmounted forms at the back of church, the Parish Office or via the parish website. All dates for the Baptism Preparation Course (for those seeking baptism for their first child) and the baptism dates are on the parish website. Click 'Sacraments' then 'Baptism'.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2022/23 applications need to be SWIFTLY RECEIVED as this weekend is the advertised closing date. The programme formally begins with the Enrolment Mass on 2<sup>nd</sup> October. Please register online at the parish website: www.ourladyofgracechiswick.org clicking 'Sacraments' then FHC.

YOUTH CONFIRMATION 2022/23. The model of the abbreviated Youth Confirmation course developed over the pandemic inbetween lockdowns is being kept for this acadmiec year. Thus, all teaching sessions will be in 2023, in the Spring and Summer Terms. Fr Daniel will publish the application process later this term as well as the dates of all teaching sessions which can be entered into family diaries early as attendance is essential and absence would likely result in being unable to proceed to Confirmation.

**ADULT CONFIRMATIONS & RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation** for Adults) or THINKING ABOUT CATHOLICISM? - If you know of anyone who is considering becoming a Catholic or if a Catholic has missed out on any of the sacraments, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the course to follow. It will be on Weds at 7.00pm from Nov 2022 to May 2023.
