Fr. Daniel writes:-		

One of Jesus' most challenging teachings is for us to
love our enemies. We can find ourselves asking God,
how can I love the one who has made my life such a
misery, the one who torments me every day, the who
did this or that to me? It is hard but then God did not
say being Holy would be easy! The people of Israel are
warned that they must not bear hatred in their hearts,
for this will corrupt their souls. Which is why one of the
central commandments of our faith is to love our
neighbour as ourselves. When we respond to hatred
-
with more hatred, we are giving the aggressor what they
want, we are playing the devil's game and perpetuating
the cycle of hatred. Instead, if we respond with a
blessing, if we respond with love, we deny hatred the
fuel it needs to flourish, we break the cycle, we start
playing God's game. Love is the antidote to hate. Jesus
asks us to love our enemies because he wants to liberate
our hearts from the prison of hatred and anger. Jesus
demonstrates this throughout his life, but especially
during his passion and death. At every point when he
was met with hatred, he responded with love.
Ultimately, as he was dying on the cross, he forgave
those who put him there. Loving our enemies is not
easy but if we want to be holy, like our God, then we
are invited to follow Jesus' example and love our
enemies. As St Paul reminds us, the 'wisdom of this
world is foolishness to God.' To love our enemies may
well seem foolish, but to God, choosing hatred over
love is even more foolish! Our world is full of enough
hatred and anger, our mission, as members of the body
of Christ, is to bring God's love and compassion alive
to all in our world. This includes to our brother or sister
who persecutes us; our colleague who makes our life a
misery; the official who denied your team three points
because they forgot to draw the VAR lines! Our Lord,
to paraphrase St Augustine, always loved the sinner and
hated the sin. We must do likewise, learning to love our
enemies because they too are made in the image and
likeness of God and because our God loves us despite
our sins. If there is to be any hope for humanity, we
must overcome our hatred, and this can only be
achieved through love.
