### Fr Daniel writes:

#### **World Youth Sunday**

The challenge as we grow up is how to find our place in the world, working out where we fit in. This is even harder for those of us who want to be faithful Catholics, as the values championed by society are no longer the same as ours. Young Catholics can have a particularly tough time of it as they find themselves caught between what can feel like two extremes, the will of God and the pressures of the secular world.

At times Christ's kingship can feel so far removed from our world that it seems far easier to discard it and say 'sorry, the way of Jesus has no place in the modern world'. Nothing could be further from the truth! Unlike the kings and rulers of this world, our God has truly become like us, he has suffered like we do, even died! He went through all this out of love for us, to rescue us from our own sinfulness, to show us the truth about our God: that he loves us and has given everything to open up a path for us to eternal life.

This is an extraordinary truth and one that can take some time to digest. Many of my secular friends when they heard I was training to be a priest would say "such a waste" or "are you mad!?" My friends who did understand were often the ones who had married out of love, they knew what it meant to love someone so much that you would do what others consider crazy to be with them. Christ our King gave his all, out of love for us. The question for each of us is how do we respond to this love?

Pope Francis last year urged young Catholics to not to be afraid to give their lives to God, to the service of others, because "life is a gift that you receive by giving yourself, and because the greatest joy is to say, unconditionally, yes to love, - as Jesus did for us." Now more than ever the world needs to be reminded of the love and mercy of Christ the King, and it is up to us to bring this wonderful truth alive in our world. We can do this by following our King's example, going against the grain, and daring to stand up for what we believe. The future is ours, and if we wish to make it a hopeful, generous and charitable future, then we need to follow the example of Christ the King, and do what we do, not for money, power, or status, but out of love for the other.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION on Cycleway 9, Chiswick High Road, Citing documentation sent from the Council: Hounslow Council has launched the construction of phase 3b of Cycleway 9 (C9), between Chiswick Lane and Heathfield Terrace. Construction is outlined for completion in mid December, subject to change depending on material availability and other logistical challenges. On Tuesday 4th October Transport for London (TfL) launched their six month public consultation surrounding the updates to the cycleway. This consultation forms an important part of the Experimental Traffic Order review process, where the feedback received, alongside monitoring data, will be used to inform the future of Cycleway 9 on Chiswick High Road. The consultation will be live until Tuesday 4th April, up until which time individuals are invited to submit as many responses as they see fit.
