# Fr Daniel writes:

### WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

On Monday I got the opportunity to visit the Tower of London and to spend some time praying in the cells where St Thomas More and St John Fisher were held before their execution. It was a humbling experience to be in the same rooms that these saints were in, to look out of the windows they would have and to pray in the same places that they would have prayed. They died for defending the faith, not with violence or by being aggressive but rather by being witnesses to the Good News in their words and their deeds.

Being a good witness of the Gospel, as Pope Francis points out, is the essence of Jesus' message to the disciples after his resurrection. "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth."

All of us who are baptised have received the wonderful gift of the Holy Spirit and so we too are called to be missionary disciples, witnesses to the Jesus where we are. How are we to be missionaries in Chiswick? What can we do to bring the love of Jesus to our neighbourhood? We can look out for the poor and needy; seek out those always alone; we can give time to help others rather than taking time only for ourselves.

We are very fortunate here to have the wonderful example of the Comboni Missionary Sisters and the Missionary Sisters of the Immaculate (PIMEs). They are living witnesses of how we can be faithful servants of God where we are, and still be joyful. They demonstrate to us that no matter where we are, no matter what part of the world we find ourselves in, we are always witnesses to our Lord through our words and actions. We pay tribute to Sr Graça Almeida of the Combonis being 'sent forth' today on a new mission assigned by her superiors to Porto in Portugal, after twelve years of service in Chiswick parish and beyond.

All of us are missionaries of Christ by virtue of our baptism. This means as Pope Francis points out that we are not called to communicate to ourselves, instead we have, "the supreme honour of presenting Christ in words and actions, proclaiming to everyone the Good News of his salvation, with joy and boldness, as the first apostles did." In the week ahead we give thanks for all those missionaries who helped pass on the Good News and we pray for those who are continuing this great work today. May we do our part to proclaim to all those we meet the Good News of salvation of Jesus Christ without fear, and above all, with immense joy!

ALSO, most appropriately, at the 12.15pm Mass today Sr Graça will be blessed and sent forth on her newly assigned mission, after twelve years in the parish and contributing so much to the parish Youth Confirmation programme in particular but also the youth group, other parish enterprises and Comboni initiatives in London and beyond. Immediately after Mass, however, there is a Reception in the Parish Centre where it will be feasible to meet Sr Graça even as we bid thanks and farewell to her. All are welcome.

ANOTHER £300 TOPPED CAFOD'S HARVEST COLLECTION coming in last weekend after the previous week's collection. Thus, to the original combined total of £1,122 (Chiswick's £950 and Grove Park's £172) is added a further £303, a final total of £1,425 is being sent off. This £1,425 itself is additional to the £2,581 raised for CAFOD's Pakistan Floods Appeal last month, a twomonth total of £4,006 rasied for CAFOD's causes alone, quite apart from the other charitable support from parish and parishioners.

**THE PARISH'S WORLD PREMIER OF 'AQUERO'**, the oratorio on the apparitions to St Bernadette of Lourdes to which Cardinal Vincent and about 160 others came on 14<sup>th</sup> October raising funds for **Friends of the Holy Land**, has raised **£4,819**. PUBLIC CONSULTATION on Cycleway 9, Chiswick High Road, Citing documentation sent from the Council: Hounslow Council has launched the construction of phase 3b of Cycleway 9 (C9), between Chiswick Lane and Heathfield Terrace. Construction is outlined for completion in mid December, subject to change depending on material availability and other logistical challenges. On Tuesday 4th October Transport for London (TfL) launched their six month public consultation surrounding the updates to the cycleway. This consultation forms an important part of the Experimental Traffic Order review process, where the feedback received, alongside monitoring data, will be used to inform the future of Cycleway 9 on Chiswick High Road. The consultation will be live until Tuesday 4th April, up until which time individuals are invited to submit as many responses as they see fit.
