CHRISTMAS DAY - THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD

Fr. Michael writes:

"If you only *knew* the *gift* of *God*!" is a line from the scriptures Pope Francis has used to exhort us to conversion of heart. The words were spoken by Jesus to the Samaritan woman at the well, found in St John's Gospel (4:1-42), as He offers her the living water, welling up from within to eternal life. Christmas is precisely the season to reflect upon and so better *know* the *gift* of *God-to-us*, which is to say, Emmanuel, *God-with-us*. A start might be by visiting prayerfully our exquisite crib or bringing a memory of the original crib in Bethlehem home to a moment's silent prayer. And what might we reflect upon in this mysterious and fruitful silence? Perhaps something akin to a passage of a 1971 homily of Pope St Paul VI which I heard some years ago at the Christmas Celebration at Westminster Cathedral:

God could have come wrapped in glory, splendour, light and power, to instil fear, to make us rub our eyes in amazement. But instead he came as the smallest, the frailest and the weakest of beings. Why? So that no one would be ashamed to approach him, so that no one would be afraid, so that all would be close to him and draw near to him, so that there would be no distance between us and him. God made the effort to plunge, to dive deep within us, so that each of us, each of you, could speak intimately with him, trust him, draw near him and realise that he thinks of you and loves you....He loves you! Think about what it means! If you understand this, if you remember what I am saying, you will have understood the whole of Christianity.

Let us make haste with the shepherds in acting upon the angels' tidings 'so that there would be no distance between us and him'. Let us join the profoundly joyful silence of the crib with Mary and Joseph, *knowing* the *gift* of *God* to us and treasuring these things in our hearts.

CHRISTMAS OFFERINGS - The offerings on Christmas Day or in envelopes marked 'Christmas Offering' are for the priests of the parish. Priests do not receive a salary and what is donated at Christmas is one of their main sources of their annual income together with the Easter offering, Mass offerings and stole fees such as those for funerals. Envelopes are at the back of the church for your kind contributions. If you are going away over Christmas you may wish to leave your offering at the presbytery.

CHURCH CHRISTMAS TREE - You are invited to place the names of your deceased relatives and friends whom you would like to remember during these days of Advent and Christmas, or any other prayer intention, on the Christmas tree at St Edward's Chapel.

CRIB OFFERINGS - The Crib Offerings by custom will go to the Westminster Catholic Children's Society to help disadvantaged children and families locally. This will help provide mental health services, family support and emergency grants for vulnerable children in our Diocese. Offerings can be made in the Crib Offering marked candle safes beside the crib. Offerings for the candles at the crib should also be placed in the Crib Offerings boxes.

ADULT CONFIRMATION – If any adult Catholic having been baptised and perhaps having made their First Holy Communion but not Confirmation would like this Easter to complete their Sacraments of Initiation, please contact Fr Michael. The course begins at 7.00pm Weds 11th Jan and runs until Easter. Details are under 'Sacraments' then 'RCIA' on the parish website.

YOUTH CONFIRMATION – has now closed and the course begins Sunday 15th Jan. Late applications might be possible until 6th Jan.

SCHOOL APPLICATIONS - To obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice, *if your Catholic practice allows for it*, you should contact the Parish Office **after the 3rd January 2023** for an appointment. Please ensure you also complete a self-assessment form by obtaining a copy from the Parish Office BEFORE meeting Fr Michael. If you are a Catholic but not a *practising* Catholic, coming to Mass *habitually*, over the last *several years* it is likely that it will be impossible for Fr Michael to issue a Certificate.

FOODBANK – The next Foodbank collection will take place on the weekend of $7^{th}/8^{th}$ January when we make our monthly collection of non-perishable items of food for families and individuals in crisis, or the cash collection for those who prefer.

CHRISTMAS MASS: 6.30pm Christmas Eve 24th Dec. The offerings of Christmas will be banked for the parish, not the priests, whose income is from Chiswick with which Grove Park is twinned.

POST- EASTER HOLIDAY PILGRIMAGE TO THE LOIRE? - The parish is planning a small group six-day coach trip 17th - 22nd April 2023 to the shrines and wines of the Loire. Based in the ancient Catholic city of Tours we'll visit the shrine of St Martin before further day trips to the medieval city and Cathedral of Orléans frequented by St Joan of Arc during the Siege of Orléans (which, against the English, she won...); also the Royal Abbey of Fontevraud, a World Heritage Site, where, among others, King Henry II of England and his son, King Richard the Lionheart, are buried; also the great Abbave Saint-Pierre de Solesmes, a vast living monastery with over 1,000 years of history as well as being custodian and promoter of Gregorian chant. Where possible Mass will be celebrated daily at the various sites. There will also be a chance to explore a few of the vineyards of the Loire's celebrated wines. Sadly we will not have time to visit any of the Loire's famous royal chateaux. Travelling by coach and Eurotunnel, and staying in central two-star ensuite accommodation, the approximate cost, while details are still to be finalised, will be £750 excluding lunch, supper and admission charges.
