Fr Daniel writes:

The third Sunday of September used to be known as 'Home Mission Sunday' but is now called **Evangelii Gaudium Sunday** ('The Joy of the Gospel' Sunday, named after Pope Francis' first Apostolic Exhortation of 2013) and it offers us the opportunity to celebrate the beauty of our faith and our commitment to witness to the fullness of life in Christ. As we hear in our Gospel this Sunday our mission to proclaim the joy of the Gospel should begin with those closest to us. If we fail it could be us and them who suffer come judgement day! This is not easy as many reject what the Gospel says because it challenges their way of living. As a good friend once said to me, "...if I accept your God then my entire way of life has to change." That is the point! We cannot encounter our risen Lord and carry on as we were.

We follow him who loved us before we were born, who loved us while we were still sinners, who died so that we might live and we do so with joy! As Pope Francis remind us, "we cannot forget that evangelisation is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ or have always rejected him." We take solace and courage from this fact, afterall, they rejected Jesus, so how can we expect any different? Our Lord walks with us and so fear should not prevent us from doing our Christian duty and bringing the Gospel alive to all we meet.

It begins at home, with our families and friends. Then it extends to our parish family and finally to the world. There are so many of you who already do so much to spread the joy of the Gospel in our parish. Thank you for all that you have done, we pray that God continues to grant you the courage to keep going. For those who are thinking about joining these wonderful Christians in their evangelisation of the parish you have many options. You could volunteer to be a catechist and help pass on the Gospel onto the next generation. You could become an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and bring our Lord in the Eucharist to those members of our parish who are sick and housebound.

As Pope Francis encourages us, we need to use what works and find new ways to bring the joy of the Gospel to those around us. This is not a job for one person but a collective effort. Only together, through sharing ideas, learning from our failures and celebrating our success will we discover new and effective ways of bringing the joy of the Gospel alive in our world today.

ALTAR SERVING RECRUITMENT – At 4.00pm Sunday 2nd Oct in church our parish Master of Ceremonies, Jim Cullen, is offering altar serving triaining for new servers. All parish children who have made their First Holy Communion are welcome to attend the session which will last for one hour. At least one parent must attend the session also. New servers, supported by their parents, will need to be ready to attend the 11.00am Sunday Mass for some time before they can return to serve at a different weekend Mass.

SCHOOL APPLICATIONS, SECONDARY AND PRIMARY, 2022. To obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP), if your Catholic practice allows for it, you should firstly contact the Parish Office to request an appointment and collect a self-assessment form (which can also be sent electronically). You should secondly complete the self-assessment form and bring it to your appointment with Fr Michael. You should not bring blank CCPs from schools. If you are a Catholic but not a practising Catholic, it will be impossible to issue a CCP as it is certifying actual Catholic practice of habitually attending weekly Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation over several years. The period of churches being closed is irrelevant because Catholic practice is to be evidenced over several years. It is also perfectly feasible to submit an application to a Catholic school without a CCP. The application would be categorised according to the admission criteria published by the school. Phone or email the office for a 10-minute slot this week within: Weds 28th 3.00-5.30pm and Thurs 29th 3.00-4.00pm. Following week: Weds 5th Oct 3.00-5.50pm; Thurs 6th 3.00-4.00pm; Fri 7th 3.00-5.50pm

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2022/23: ANY LAST applications need to be SWIFTLY RECEIVED as the programme formally begins with the Enrolment Mass on 2nd October. Please register online at the parish website: www.ourladyofgracechiswick.org clicking 'Sacraments' then FHC.

YOUTH CONFIRMATION 2022/23. The Youth Confirmation developed over the pandemic is being kept for this acadmicc year. Thus, all teaching sessions will be in 2023, in the Spring and Summer Terms. Fr Daniel will publish the application process later this term as well as the dates of all teaching sessions which can be entered into diaries early as attendance is essential and absence would likely result in being unable to proceed to Confirmation.

EXTRACT FROM EVANGELII GAUDIUM paragraphs 2&3: The great danger in today's world, pervaded as it is by consumerism, is the desolation and anguish born of a complacent yet covetous heart, the feverish pursuit of frivolous pleasures, and a blunted conscience. Whenever our interior life becomes caught up in its own interests and concerns, there is no longer room for others, no place for the poor. God's voice is no longer heard, the guiet joy of his love is no longer felt, and the desire to do good fades. This is a very real danger for believers too. Many fall prey to it, and end up resentful, angry and listless. That is no way to live a dignified and fulfilled life; it is not God's will for us, nor is it the life in the Spirit which has its source in the heart of the risen Christ. I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her. The Lord does not disappoint those who take this risk; whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that he is already there, waiting for us with open arms. Now is the time to say to Jesus: "Lord, I have let myself be deceived; in a thousand ways I have shunned your love, yet here I am once more, to renew my covenant with you. I need you. Save me once again, Lord, take me once more into your redeeming embrace".
