### Fr Michael writes:

2nd JULY 2023

A joy this weekend in the parish will be the enrolment at the 11.00am Mass of new altar servers in the Archconfraternity and Guild of St Stephen for Altar Servers. We enroll both on St Stephen's Day, 26<sup>th</sup> December, the Guild's principal Feast, but also on the nearest Sunday to the Feast of Sts Peter and Paul because of the Guild's close association with the Holy See. So precocious was the rise of the Guild that though founded at parish level in Hammersmith in 1904, Pope Pius X himself established it in 1905 as newly based at Westminster Cathedral with the Archbishop of Westminster as its Superior-General and in the following year created it not only the Guild but the Archconfraternity of St Stephen with parishes beyond the Diocese being able to affiliate which they have now done from across the world. The young servers learn not only to understand what they are doing and why, - and therefore with the utmost reverence and love - but also that life is vocational, that as disciples of Christ and inspired by his first martyr, St Stephen, we learn to give of ourselves in service of God and neighbour. As we applaud these young disciples making their Guild Promise we might usefully ask for the grace to renew our own readiness to live, as the Guild Promise has it, "for the glory of God, the service of His Church and my own eternal salvation.

### Welcome to Fr Damian Wachowiak

Fr Damian arrives this weekend fresh from his studies for the month of July to enjoy something of London as well as to enable holidays for we residents. Fr Damian is from the Archdiocese of Poznań in central eastern Poland, the oldest and original diocese of that country founded over 1,000 years ago in 968!

## July: the month of the Precious Blood

Westminster Cathedral is dedicated to the Most Precious Blood and it was about this that Pope Benedict, at his Mass there in 2010, spoke these words: The outpouring of Christ's blood is the source of the Church's life. St John sees in the water and blood which flowed from our Lord's body the wellspring of that divine life which is bestowed by the Holy Spirit and communicated to us in the sacraments. Faithful to Christ's command to 'do this in memory of me' the Church in every time and place celebrates the Eucharist until the Lord returns, rejoicing in his sacramental presence and drawing on the power of his saving sacrifice. The Eucharistic sacrifice embraces in turn the mystery of our Lord's continuing passion in the members of his body, the Church. Here the great crucifix serves as a reminder that Christ, our eternal high priest, daily unites our own sacrifices, our own sufferings, our own needs, hopes and aspirations, to the infinite merits of his sacrifice. Through him, with him and in him, we lift up our own bodies as a sacrifice holy and acceptable to God, caught up in his eternal oblation, completing in our flesh what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the Church.
