### Fr Michael writes:

"Were your faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." How Jesus longs for us to have faith! His miracles helped as the scriptures and especially The Acts of the Apostles go on to show. The disciples too worked miracles in their turn, their lives lived in their faith in the presence of the Risen Christ with them in their ministry; their recognition of His being among them as they continued His mission. October, being the Month of the Rosary, offers us a help focussing us on His presence among us too, and our mysteriously sharing even now in the mysteries of His life, death and resurrection. Contemplating with Mary, the perfect model of a faith-filled life, of a heart and its love conformed to Christ's, in praying the Rosary, even a single decade a day, we look beyond ourselves, fanning into a flame the faith we have been given as St Paul says in the Second Reading, to the Lord, to Him whose life we share in the Holy Spirit. Through faith we learn to love if as sinners also as those becoming saints as it is our faith, mothered as it were by Mary's and given by God, that enables us to see as Christ sees and so to look with His compassion upon the world in need. St Bernard writes: 'The Word became flesh and now dwells among us. He dwells in our hearts through faith, he dwells in our memory and thoughts, he penetrates even to our above imagination. was our understanding. unapproachable; he was completely invisible and beyond our intellect; but now he wished to be comprehended, to be seen, to be pondered. But how? you may ask. I answer: lying in a manger, resting on a virgin's bosom, preaching on the mount, spending the night in prayer; or hanging on the cross; or rising again on the third day, showing the apostles the print of the nails, the sign of victory, and finally ascending from their sight into heaven. Is there anything here that cannot be reflected on, truthfully, lovingly, reverently? If I reflect on any of these things, I reflect on God, and in all of them I find my God.

Tomas Krejci is a former Anglican clergyman who will be assisting in our parish this academic year while he attends classes at Allen Hall Seminary as a diocesan seminarian. He was born in Prague, Czech Republic; for over two decades he was working as a solicitor for an international US-based law firm, his work taking him to a great number of countries around the world. His Old Catholic background brought him to the Church of England where, following the completion of his studies in theology at Oxford, he was ordained and worked for three years in a parish in Reading. In his free time he also enjoys travelling, in particular pilgrimages to Marian shrines. We welcome him and all he will do among us.

CAFOD'S HARVEST FAMILY FAST DAY THIS FRIDAY – East Africa is in the midst of a terrible food crisis affecting millions of people; a food crisis that could be the worst in living memory. Across Kenya, Ethiopia, South Sudan and in Somalia, families are facing extreme levels of hunger and malnutrition. Four years of drought have exacerbated existing food and water shortages in the region and, tragically, famine is now looming. Next weekend there'll be the routine autumn CAFOD collection for this particuarl cause, grateful as CAFOD is for your generosity a fortnight ago for the Pakistan Floods Emergency Appeal. SCHOOL APPLICATIONS, SECONDARY AND PRIMARY, 2022. To obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP), if your Catholic practice allows for it, you should firstly contact the Parish Office to request an appointment and collect a self-assessment form (which can also be sent electronically). You should **secondly** complete the self-assessment form and bring it to your appointment with Fr Michael. You should not bring blank CCPs from schools. If you are a Catholic but not a practising Catholic, it will be impossible to issue a CCP as it is certifying actual Catholic practice of habitually attending weekly Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation over several years. The period of churches being closed is irrelevant because Catholic practice is to be evidenced over several vears. It is also perfectly feasible to submit an application to a Catholic school without a CCP. The application would be categorised according to the admission criteria published by the school. Phone or email the office for a 10-minute slot this week within: Weds 5th Oct 3.00-5.50pm; Thurs 6<sup>th</sup> 3.00-4.00pm; Fri 7<sup>th</sup> 3.00-5.50pm. The following week: Weds 12th 3.00-5.50pm; Thurs 13th 3.00-4.00pm; Fri 14th 3.00-4.00pm.
