Fr Michael writes.

Fr John arrives

Fr John Mbinda CSSp is just beginning his ministry among us this weekend and it has been a great joy to welcome him. Even if it was, I suppose, to be expected from someone whose great expertise and experience has come from another region of the universal Church, nonetheless, what a refreshing thing it is to encounter insight and perspective not one's own as well as the many matters and concerns which are universal. As well as most recently completing a six year term as the Provincial of his Order in Kenya and South Sudan, he has experience of strategies for poverty reduction and sustainable livelihoods, skills which might well be transferrable to situations existing and worsening in London; he has also lectured in Mission at university - holding also a Masters' degree in Development Studies - and experience in school governance and administration across all Spiritan schools in two countries. I'm sure, therefore, we'll all have much to be grateful for in his ministry in Chiswick, Gunnersbury and Grove Park. As for himself, he says he's very much looking forward to serving as an Assistant Priest in our parishes and, among other good things, not having great administrative responsibilities but essentially pastoral ones. Let us make him most welcome.

Development Opportunities after Easter

Being now in the exceptional situation of having three priests in the parishes, I'd be very keen to hear parishioners' views of what we might either restore from pre-pandemic times or develop for however long we will retain three priests. I've very conscious that there is no week day evening Mass for parishioners whose working hours preclude them attending Mass in the week. Would a 7.00pm or 7.30pm Mass be well received, or would parishioners want the return of two lunchtime Masses at 12.30pm as it was pre-Covid? The pandemic put an end to a year-long Bible course we had just begun in 2019. Should this now return? In due course after Easter I'll schedule a Sunday afternoon parish discussion to listen, consider and subsequently respond to suggestions. Alternatively, please write in or speak to any of the priests on your thoughts.

In the meantime, feet

Not since Holy Thursday 2018 have we had the washing of the feet at the Mass of the Lord's Supper. It would be wonderful to assemble 12 volunteers who'd be attending that Mass to be prepared just for that solemn moment after the homily to come from the congregation to the sanctuary, to the altar, the Table of the Last Supper, and to have a foot washed and dried for the spiritual edification of us all. A) WEEKLY SPIRITUAL EXERCISES FOR LENT:

<u>TUESDAYS</u> 6.30pm to 7.30pm: 'ENCOUNTERING THE SPIRIT' – a small group prayer experience based on the spiritual listening and speaking learned from the synodal process. Each week we will reflect together on the previous Sunday's Gospel and how to put it into practice. The meeting, the last in this series, is on **Tuesday** 5th April in the St Edward's Room on the theme of 'The Temple'.

<u>WEDNESDAYS</u> after Mass from 10.30am to 12.00 noon: EXPOSITION and BENEDICTION. The Rosary will follow 10.00am Mass as usual but in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Perhaps leave and return; perhaps just drop in for extra prayer. Benediction will be at 12.00 noon.

<u>FRIDAYS</u> **6.00pm: STATIONS OF THE CROSS.** Following the Angelus at 6.00pm, there will be a liturgical celebration of the Stations of the Cross. Those present may process behind the priest around the church at the Stations or remain in pews as preferred. (This is the last 6.00pm liturgical celebration of the Stations as the following Friday is Good Friday.)

B) LENT PROJECT 2022:

As pre-pandemic, we'll have a dual Lent Project, one *domestic* and one *overseas*. In the first three weeks of Lent: £6496 *Thank you*.

The CARDINAL'S APPEAL is our domestic project and this year the appeal will fund parish social outreach projects and Caritas Westminster (celebrating this year its 10th year of foundation) social outreach projects. For what it does and which projects are supported see: https://www.caritaswestminster.org.uk/ There are specific Cardinal's Appeal envelopes at the exits of the church.

<u>COMBONI-150</u> is our overseas project, clelebrating also the 150th anniversary of foundation of the Comboni Missionaries. All funds given through the parish will go directly to assist Comboni Sr Rosemary Herrera (no relation of Fr Daniel...) in Arequipa, Peru. She is hoping for a total of £4855 in support of her ecological project among families in subsistence living. The project aims to provide two bio-gardens as 'sow a seed and you feed a village' but also, in the interim, some food parcels and meals to those developing these gardens which will belong to the villagers.

CASH placed in the Lent Project money box at the main doors of the church will be divided 65% for Comboni-150 and 35% Cardinal's Appeal. Cash placed in envelopes maked for either charity and handed into the collection or the presbytery will go 100% to the named charity. Cheques should be payable to 'Our Lady of Grace and St Edward's Church' and come in an envelope marked with the designated charity.

At this Mass the oils of Chrism, Catechumens and the Sick, are blessed and consecrated for use in the parishes in the coming year. (The 10.00am Parish Mass is scheduled as normal.)
