## Fr Michael writes:

It's not Liz Truss or Rishi Sunak alone taking up a new appointment this week – and for whom we should pray and for the formation of the new Government – but here in the parish too it's a whirligig of change. Both of our new Assistant Priests arrive this week with their ministry beginning, very appropriately, around Thursday 8th September, the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a feast in the Church which has long been associated with new beginnings, particularly for consecrated Religious, men and women, either in entering their noviciate or, having been professed, entering into ministry. This might of course, looking at the matter prosaically, be just to do with the date being a feast helpfully placed at the beginning of the traditional academic year. But it is apposite, too, theologically, in the fact that Mary's birth into the world, following her Immaculate Conception, is the beginning of her vocation and ministry which she grew into through her subsequent birthdays to be the mother of Jesus. Mother of God. Queen of Heaven, Mother of the Church, and thus our mother too. Just as her progress was filled with grace and fruit, so we may all who invoke her aid each passing year on 8th September, expect her assistance on our new or renewed vocation and ministry. Thus let us pray this week for Fr Daniel Daley and Fr Erasmus Egenonu CSSp, the latter arriving on the BVM's birthday itself.

Fr Daniel is a priest of Westminster Diocese and this is his first appointment, having been ordained priest by Cardinal Vincent earlier this summer. It is an immense joy to welcome a newly ordained priest to Chiswick, Gunnersbury and Grove Park as well as of course a privilege and a responsibility. Here he will grow into ministry through both challenges and joys. We will all have a hand in assisting him as the experience he has here will certainly shape his future ministry which we ask God to bless abundantly.

Fr Erasmus is a priest of the Spiritan Order, the Holy Ghost Fathers, and has been ordained priest for just over twenty years. He has held senior positions in the Nigerian Province of the Order as well as having ministered in UK parishes assigned to the Order, most recently as a Parish Priest in the Archdiocese of Liverpool for four years. He will be taking some sabbatical courses in London while also ministering as Assistant Priest in our parishes.

We welcome them both and pray that they will receive through us all that the Lord intends for them just as we hope to receive the grace of God through the generous labours of their ministry too. An opportune moment to meet them will be at the reception in the Parish Centre next Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> Sept from 12.00 noon to 2.00pm at which we formally bid farewell to Fr Daniel Herrero (speeches about 1.10pm) as we also welcome his successors.
