PENTECOST SUNDAY

Fr Daniel writes:

Fifty days or seven weeks after the Feast of Easter the Jewish People celebrate the feast of Pentecost, from the Greek πεντηκοστη, which means "fiftieth", because it is the fiftieth day after Easter. The feast is also known by its Hebrew name Shavuot (שבועות), which means "weeks" referring to the seven weeks that separates it from Easter.

The feast of Pentecost commemorated the day in which God, seven weeks after rescuing the Israelites from the slavery in Egypt, appeared on Mount Sinai. There, He established with them a Covenant and gave them the Ten Commandments. A gift that had the power to radically transform a group of slaves into the people of God. We can find in the book of Exodus the account of what happened that day: *There was thunder and lightning, as well as a thick cloud on the mountain, and a blast of a trumpet so loud that the people who were in the camp trembled. Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God. They took their stand at the foot of the mountain. Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke, because the Lord had descended upon it in fire, the smoke went out like the smoke of a kiln, while the whole mountain shook violently (Ex 19:16-18).*

The experience of the Israelites on Mount Sinai is strikingly similar to what happened to the Apostles the day of Pentecost, fifty days after the resurrection of Christ. They were together in a room when suddenly a mighty wind blasted the house where they were, shaking it, and fire appeared that divided and rested on each of them. It was the new Pentecost, the day in which God manifested himself again – as on Mount Sinai. Only that this time God did not intend to speak exclusively to the Israelites. Instead, he separated from the Israelites a small group, the twelve apostles, and filled them with the Holy Spirit. A gift that transformed a group of fearful people into a community strongly bound together by love and empowered them to proclaim the Good News everywhere.

Such unity and courage became for all around them the unmistakable sign that heaven was now permanently present on earth. Humanity, which had been plagued by fear and division ever since they were expelled from Eden, could now look forward to a new future. "*The wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid, and the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them. The cow and the bear shall feed; their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. The sucking child shall play over the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the adder's den. They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.*" (Isa 11:1-9)

LENT PROJECT 2022:, CLOSING TODAY

As pre-pandemic, we'll have a dual Lent Project, one *domestic* and one *overseas*. **£10,506 has been donated todate**. *Thank you*.

The CARDINAL'S APPEAL is our domestic project and this year the appeal will fund parish social outreach projects and Caritas Westminster (celebrating this year its 10th year of foundation) social outreach projects. For what it does and which projects are supported see: <u>https://www.caritaswestminster.org.uk/</u> There are specific Cardinal's Appeal envelopes at the exits of the church.

<u>COMBONI-150</u> is our overseas project, clelebrating also the 150th anniversary of foundation of the Comboni Missionaries. All funds given through the parish will assist Comboni Sr Rosemary Herrera in Arequipa, Peru, hoping for a total of £4855. The project aims to provide two bio-gardens as 'sow a seed and you feed a village' but also, in the interim, some food parcels and meals to those developing these gardens which will belong to the villagers.

CASH placed in the Lent Project money box at the main doors of the church will be divided 65% for Comboni-150 and 35% Cardinal's Appeal. Cash placed in envelopes maked for either charity and handed into the collection or the presbytery will go 100% to the named charity. Cheques should be payable to 'Our Lady of Grace and St Edward's Church' and come in an envelope marked with the designated charity.

BISHOP JOHN MBINDA CSSp – Our erstwhile Second Assistant Priest from 1st to 3rd April 2022(!) was ordained 4th Bishop of Lodwar in Kenya on Saturday 4th June.
