## 15<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### Fr Michael writes:

"We may not even be aware of it, but every time we go to Mass, the first reason is that we are drawn there by the Lord's desire for us" (§6). These words come from early in the Apostolic Letter that Pope Francis has just published and therefore 'sent' to the whole Church and quite specifically, too, to the lay faithful. The letter is entitled 'With desire I have desired', or more technically in its Latin title, Desiderio Desideravi, which is citing the Lord's words at the beginning of the Last Supper in St Luke's account, more usually translated in English as "I have longed [to eat this Passover with you]" (Lk 22:15). The letter's subtitle clarifies the subject: On the Liturgical Formation of the People of God.

The letter is immensely rich and, at 20 pages, can be read in one sitting but bears much deeper reflection. Given that the "liturgy is the first source of divine communion in which God shares his own life with us" (§30) the Holy Father's "fundamental question is this: how do we recover the capacity to live completely the liturgical action?" (§27). Mass is to encounter and experience the Paschal Mystery and then, with the grace of God, to live it. He then cites the very line from the Rite of Ordination of a Priest which I recall quoting on the newsletter last Good Shepherd Sunday but offered as applying to all the baptised: 'Understand what you will do, imitate what you will celebrate and conform your life to the mystery of the Lord's Cross'.

However, "From...the nature of the Liturgy it becomes clear that knowledge of the mystery of Christ...does not consist in a mental assimilation of some idea bit in real existential engagement with his person. The celebration concerns the reality of our being docile to the action of the Spirit who operates through it until Christ be formed in us. The full extent of our formation is our conformation to Christ. I repeat: it does not have to do with an abstract mental process, but with becoming Him. This is the purpose for which the Spirit is given, whose action is always and only to confect the Body of Christ. Leo the Great writes, "Our participation in the Body and Blood of Christ has no other end than to make us become that which we eat"" (§41).

"Let us allow ourselves to be embraced by the desire that the Lord continues to have to eat His Passover with us," (§65) the Pope exhorts us as he concludes, but not before finally quoting a letter from his beloved patron, St Francis of Assisi, to his Order: "Let everyone be struck with fear, let the whole world tremble, and let the heavens exult when Christ, the Son of the living God, is present on the altar in the hands of a priest! Hold back nothing of yourselves for yourselves, that He Who gives Himself totally to you may receive you totally!"

Fr Daniel Daley will move into Chiswick in September to take up his appointment. Bishop John Mbinda's Holy Ghost Father replacement has also been announced by the Spiritans & Diocese. We will look forward to welcoming Fr Erasmus Onyema Egenonu CSSp also in September and trust, if God's Will, that he might stay in the parish a little longer than his illustrious predecessor!
